Minutes

Old Business

A. Cemetery Work: Sue reported that the contractor, Jonathan Appell, has not yet begun work, but she hopes that he will be here soon. It is getting late in the year.

B. Grist Mill Update: Elizabeth said that Candy Stellmach reports that work on the State Register nomination is progressing. The need for repairs is pressing, but so far the town has not committed the funds.

C. Oral History Project: Elizabeth reported that the first interview, with Bud Palmer, has been completed and was very successful. Unfortunately, there was some difficulty with the audio system, so further interviews are on hold until the equipment works to everyone's satisfaction.

D. New Members: Elizabeth reminded the members that we need to recruit new people for the Commission.

New Business

Annual Report: Elizabeth asked for input for the Commission's annual report, which is due late next month. Subjects include, besides our demolition permit records, the cemetery repairs, work on the grist mill, and the 375th anniversary celebration, on which committee Sue will serve.
